SOCIAL EVENTS UPDATE

On May 24th our **Indian Evening** was held at the Centre in the Lumley Room with a full audience to enjoy the experience of our guest speaker, Pam Goodall (also known as 'Pam on a Bike'). There must be something about Emsworth and cyclists – last year our Italian evening speaker took us all over Italy on his bike and this year Pam Goodall took us through India and Pakistan.

Pam had made the daring decision just before the Millennium to set off around the world on her bike alone. So in the spring of 2001 she left the comfort of her West Sussex home to pedal her way through Europe, Asia and then America. For us she was able to highlight her time in India and Pakistan telling us of her

adventures with a few slides to illustrate her experiences. Pam has since written a book about her journey – it's called 'Riding it Out' should you want to know how she fared in other parts of the world. Her light hearted approach gave a wonderful start to the evening which was then followed by a sumptuous meal which had been so expertly prepared by our local Indian restaurant in the Square – 'Taste of India'. With requests beforehand for 'mild', 'not too hot', 'some vegetarian' food we carefully selected about 10 different dishes with 8 vegetable dishes, 2 rices and nan bread which arrived piping hot and ready to serve after Pam's talk. This meal was enjoyed by all and rounded off with a simple ice cream, then tea and coffee. To finish the evening our Monday evening Belly Dancing group, who meet in the Lumley Room weekly, gave us a display of their talents, some of whom have never danced to an audience before. They were wonderful. The colours of the dresses covered in jewels and sequins along with stunning head dresses were spectacular and thoroughly appreciated by all. Well, where shall we go next year – it's up to you.
